SUPERINDENDENT DUTIES:

Superintendent will generally be responsible for the overall manpower and scheduling of multiple projects in size of 1M to 15M after project award. Projects types and sizes will vary however all projects will be of commercial construction, either renovation or new construction. We perform a variety of projects including Assisted Living Facilities, Healthcare, MOB's, Office, etc. Field Superintendent will oversee project manpower, and will review field installation, execution, and safety. Typically, the PM's will coordinate project submittals, quoted materials and pricings. The superintendent duties will include but not be limited to:

- Attend virtual/onsite scheduling meetings.
- Coordinate with project foreman upcoming project activities and milestones.
- Coordinate with PM to ensure project materials are available to meet project schedule.

- Review and understand project documents, proposals, and GC Scope of Work.
- Work with project foreman/PM to develop construction plan.
- Supervise approx. 50-100 field electricians.
- Coordinate with different utilities on project outages.
- Be able to occasionally develop and design temporary electrical infrastructures that will of sufficient size to meet project temporary power needs for lighting and power.
